Updated Policies for 2018

Bloom has two updated policies in our parent handbook. The 2018 parent handbook can be found on-line at www.bloomearlylearning.org. If you have any questions regarding the parent handbook please stop in the office.

The first policy is regarding new enrollment.

Upon enrollment you will provide a onetime \$100 non-refundable deposit that goes towards the first tuition payment. A onetime \$60 registration fee is also required at this time.

Families must start when the opening becomes available. If circumstances arise that delays the child's start date a family can hold the spot by paying 75% of the fulltime tuition for up to 3 months to save the spot.

The second updated is an addition to our emergency drill procedures. This policy is in compliance with Minnesota's DHS.

In the event of an emergency Bloom has plans in place that involve relocation, evacuation, and lock down scenarios. In the event of an emergency situation Bloom would contact the parents using the emergency card information. At that time we would share the situation and provide you with the steps to safely be reunited with your child(ren).

Bloom's first relocation destination is Northwest Family Physicians located across the street at 1495 Cty rd 101

Bloom's second relocation destination is The Original Pancake House located across the street at 1415 Cty rd 101

Bloom's third relocation destination is Interfaith Outreach & Community Partners located across the intersection at 1605 Cty rd 101

The staff are trained for emergency situations annually. Please make sure that you keep your child's emergency information current. Emergency cards will be review annually in the fall for all children.
