

~Infants~

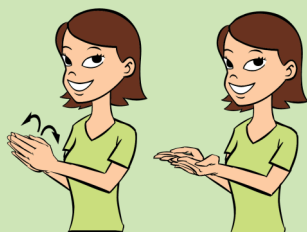
