

Toddlers

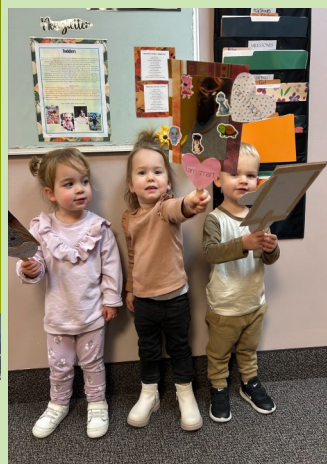
